<b>Funding for Bridge</b>	Taking inflation into consideration, the group decided to use \$40,000 as the target for total matching funds. Because the CIP “ceiling” is \$20,000, the group decided to fundraise \$21,000 and request the town pick up the difference of \$19,000. The \$21,000 should be raised before March. For those who don't exactly know where the proposed bridge is to go: walk down the conservation trail at the back of Mill Street. Approximately 300 steps in, there is a stonewall and a sign that indicates the end of the conservation area. It is there, just before the wall, that a path to the bridge footing will diverge toward the water. It's an easy walk to the river from there (for now, it's easiest to walk on the non-conservation side of the wall).
