RFP Municipal Solid Waste Disposal

The Town of New Boston is requesting proposals for the disposal 900 tons of residentially generated solid waste delivered to you facility Starting January 1st 2016. We have a very strong recycling program in place and allow minimal non burnable materials into the waste stream. We do not allow commercial dumping at our facility.

Bids should be for a minimum of 3 years and up to 5. Depending on the contract pricing New Boston will entertain an extended contract.

New Boston generates approximately 200 tons of Construction Debris and will consider contract pricing on material delivered to your facility. Demolition pricing will not affect MSW contract award and will be a separate contract.

New Boston will award contract based on what is best for the town, taking into consideration logistics, ease of operation and contract pricing. All interested parties are welcome and encouraged to visit the New Boston Transfer Station to assist in the RFP process.

New Boston Transfer Station

Concrete and ceramic disposal

Currently the Transfer Station receives concrete materials, bathroom and kitchen ceramics and stone materials at no charge to the resident. In the past we have been able to give the material away as clean fill. Due to the difficulty of finding an appropriate disposal location in a timely manner and so that the storage capacity of the facility is not exceeded, adding these materials to the list as a demolition fee item will resolve this issue.

Concrete is already on the fee structure list. The only operational change will be closing the current dumping area on the west side of the property and requiring materials to be weighed and placed in demolition containers at the current "Category 1" fee of .07 cents per pound.

These adjustments will cover the cost of roll off from East coast Electronics current fee of \$785.00

Price was raised last year from \$650.00.

This fee covers trucking, storage trailer and disposal.
