


Dear New Boston,

## AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

---

This program runs in conjunction with the school calendar and provides a safe haven for our children until 6:00 pm. The Director and Assistant of this program pick up the children inside the school and walk them down to the White Buildings for the program. The program is for children in grades K\* - 6th (\*afternoon kindergarten students only) and begins Thursday, September 6th and runs until the last day of school in June. Children enjoy supervised play, crafts, sports... and more. If you are interested in our After School program please contact us soon. This program fills up quickly and we usually work off a waiting list through out the school year.



## PLAY GROUP

---

Our Play Group is for families with young children and is so popular they meet two mornings a week. One group meets on Tuesdays and the other on Wednesdays from 9:30 - 11 A.M. at the White Buildings throughout the school year. During the summer they take advantage of the nice weather and meet at a group member's home. This is a great way for children and parents to make new friends. Registration is required and a fee of \$30 per family for the year is charged. Registration begins August 7, 2006. Space is limited so register early.



## SENIOR CITIZENS

---

Our Senior programs include weekly lunches, monthly blood pressure clinics, monthly movies and field trips. We also have a free monthly newsletter that is mailed. If you are, or know of a Senior and would like the newsletter, please contact us, we would love to add you to our list. Senior lunches are on Tuesdays and Thursday through out the school year. Lunch is at 11:15 am at the New Boston Central School Gym and runs in conjunction with the NB Central School Hot Lunch Program. Watch our monthly Senior Newsletter for dates and menu. The cost is \$2 or what ever you can afford. Blood pressure clinics are held the 1st Thursday of the month at the school in conjunction with the lunches. We also have other programs, like movies and trips, that are advertised in our newsletter.



## WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

---

We offer a woman's basketball program on Mondays at the New Boston Central School Gym from 7:30-9:00 PM. This is a casual, pick up type of program. Join the ladies to shoot some hoops, get some exercise and have fun, you deserve some time too. There is no fee but registration is required. The next session starts Monday, September 11 and goes to October 30th. The spring schedule is tentatively set for March 19, 2007 through June 18, 2007. ## GYMNASTICS

---

This is one of our most popular programs and it fills up fast. Classes are available for children ages 18 months to grade 6. All classes are held at the New Boston Central School Gym and are instructed by Karen Hall and Sheri Moloney. This is a great way to introduce young children to gymnastics or have the older ones enhance their skills and techniques. The fall schedule is as follows:

Tuesdays; September 12 - October 24

2:30-3:15 PM - Girls ages 5-7

3:15-4:00 PM - Boys & Girls ages 3&4

3:15-4:00 PM - Girls ages 8-12

4:00-4:45 PM - Advanced Girls ages 6-12

Wednesdays; September 13—November 1 (no class 9/27/06)

2:30-3:15 PM - Boys & Girls ages 3&4

3:15-4:00 PM - Boys & Girls ages 5-12

4:00-4:45 PM - Boys & Girls ages 5-8

4:00-4:45 PM - Parent/Tot ages 18 months - 2 years



The fee for this first session is \$49. Pre-registration and payment are required.

Registration for fall classes will be held Monday, August 21 through Monday, August 28 during Town Hall hours at the Recreation Department. Forms can be picked up, completed and dropped off with payment in the appropriate class box. Classes will be filled by a lottery-type selection and you will be called to confirm your child's spot in class.

We will have one box per class. You are asked to mark ,on your registration form, your first choice class along with a second and/or third if available. Place the registration form & payment in your first choice class's box. We try our best to get every interested child in the program.

As always, we register New Boston residents first. If space is available and no New Boston resident is on the wait list we will then offer the program to non-New Boston residents.

## YOGA

Relax the mind and strengthen the body with Certified Integral Yoga Instructor Catherine Martin. All classes are held at the White Buildings (located to the right of NB Central School). Fall Class Schedule:

## ARCHERY

We have scheduled archery classes for Mondays, September 18 through October 16th (no class 10/9/06). The Beginner class is 4:30-5:30 PM and the Advanced class is from 5:30-6:30 PM. All classes will be held at the New Boston Central School gym. Participants must be age 7 or older. The fee is \$55 for either class, space is limited, pre-registration and pre-payment are required by September 11.

Get creative New Boston! Our famous Scarecrow Alley is coming to life again. New Boston residents are encouraged to make a scarecrow(s) and display it/them on the town's common. Scarecrows can be put up beginning on Saturday, September 30 and must be taken down by Sunday, October 29th. We will have ballot boxes at the town hall, Whipple Free Library and Dodge's Store so everyone can cast their vote. Cash prizes will be awarded at the Halloween Party on Tuesday, October 31st at NBCS. You can register as a family, business or organization and prizes will be awarded in each category. There is no cost to register your creation, but you must register it with the Recreation Department to receive a number for judging. The Recreation Department and Whipple Free Library co-sponsor this event.

Our annual Golf Tournament will be held at Crotched Mt. Golf Club (formally Tory Pines) in Franconstown on Sunday, October 8th. This program is for boys and girls in grades K - 8th. Children in grades K-2 participate on Saturday mornings with their season starting in December and going through February. Children in grades 3-8 have practices and games during the week and weekends, starting in mid-November and going through late February/early March. This program is totally dependent on volunteers so please consider donating some of your time; we need coaches, referees and concession stand help. Registrations will be accepted from Sunday, October 1st thru Friday, October 13th for a fee of \$45 and from Saturday, October 14th thru Tuesday, October 31st for a fee of \$55. ***This program will be available for online registration!***

## TEEN DODGEBALL




