

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 24, 1979

Present were Roland Sallada, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper.

Wayne Robinson, auctioneer, was asked to come to discuss his rental of the Town Hall for auction purposes. There has been disapproval of the condition of the hall after his auctions. He did not meet the standards with which the Town Hall Committee outlined in their regulations.

In his defence, he said he felt he has done everything possible to leave the hall as required. Roland said the complaints against him were involving the leaving of rubbish and not setting the tables and chairs back the way originally found. Wayne explained that the rubbish situation in New Boston is a great inconvenience with no proper disposal and he stated that he feels the \$25 deposit is unjust. He said he will pay the rent by check but will offer the deposit in cash.

Cindy Fletcher, Bruce Vaal and Andrew Gallagher came in to ask permission to conduct an outdoor activity on the property of Paul Buchanan on the Frankestown Turnpike to celebrate the Goffstown graduation. They were advised that the owner of the property must apply for the permit. They agreed to come in next week with Mr. Buchanan.

Mr. Thomas McGann dropped by to get the facts on advertising signs which he has permitted to be placed on his property on the corner of Old Coach Rd. and Route 13. He was given the dimensions allowed.
