Mr. Bruce Sartwell, Private Investigator, came in to question the

owner of the property had requested a permit for this occasion and the

they were informed there would be no liquor. Mr. Sartwell seemed satisfied
with the answers and said he would now contact Police Chief Ballou.

Mr. Graham Pendlebury came in to discuss the Peter Kaufman land which
he has purchased; he asked for, and received, a bill necessary to remove
three acres from Current Use, leaving the balance as is.

Sel. Olson reported being approached by Mr. Joshua Dodge asking if it
would be possible to erect a street light in front of his property on
Old Coach Road ~~xxxx~~ being that it is very dark and fears for the safety
of cars left in the driveway. The Selectmen will consider the matter.
