

SELECTMENAS MEETING

Feb. 18, 1982

Present were Sel. Todd, Sel. Olson and Sel. Mansfield. Also Secretary.

Paul Delphia came in to ask permission to use the town hall parking lot on March 14 to handle the over-flow from a horse show to be held at the 4-H grounds. The public is invited, therefore he feels there would be a scarcity of parking at the grounds. Permission granted.

George Hawkins came in to ask the status of the Follansbee land on Saunders Rd. which was taken by the town for delinquent taxes. He was advised that the town still owns the property and no decision has been made for its disposal.

A pistol permit was issued to Thomas Foster, Jr. (renewal)

The Selectmen met with the Conservation Commission regarding town lands. It was understood by the Commission that some of the town property that had been lumbered had not been done well. They asked who would over-see these projects. Mrs. Brooks also asked what policy is taken if complaints of this work were made. Sel. Mansfield advised that the Forestry Committee would over-see any forestry projects. Sel. Todd said if there were any complaints regarding the work, the situation should be first brought to the attention of the Selectmen. Ray Wheeler offered to prepare a map indicating location of all town lands. The Selectmen were then asked what decisions had been made regarding oiling roads. The Selectmen reported that \$2,500 had been budgeted for dust control, which would be for calcium, not oil.

Martha Brooks, chairman of the Commission, thanked the Selectmen for their cooperation during the past year.
