

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 29, 1982

Richard Dilley came in in response to an appointment extended to him by the Board of Selectmen as alternate to the Board of Adjustment. The Selectmen enlightened him on what is expected and, being satisfied, he accepted the appointment.

James Huett came in to see if the Selectmen had made a decision regarding replacement of wells on Old Coach Road which ~~are~~ contain salt which apparantly drains from the road. He was advised that the town has offered to dig ditches for drainage away from the dwellings and gravel will be brought in ~~to~~ for filter.

Arthur Fortier came in regarding his property tax delinquent notice. He owes a balance and was concerned about losing his house. The Tax Sale law was explained to him which put him at ease.

John Bunting came in regarding the bids on the sprinkler system for the library. He feels that the Fire Dept. will accept the bid from Styvertson Inc. which was the low bid. The Fire Dept. is also contacting local electrical contractors to ~~xi~~ install the Fire Alarm Equipment for town buildings as per the adoption of Art. #9 at town meeting..

It was noted and appreciated that Sel. Caldwell replaced the old worn flag with a new one which was donated by the American Legion Post #19.

Regarding the trailer hearing held April 15 at the request of Roger Belanger, the Selectmen's decision was to allow a two-year temporary permit. Mr. Belanger and all abutters will be notified to come to the Selectmen's Office to sign the permit at their earliest convenience.
