

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 6, 1982

At the request of Mr. Andrew Belanger, a Trailer Hearing was held at 8:00 pm with Mr. Belanger present and no abutters attended. Mr. Belanger wished to place a trailer on the site ~~of~~ where a previous trailer had been eight years ^{ago} but burned. He agreed to set the trailer on a cement foundation and join it to his own home with a breezeway. There will be ten feet between buildings and the purpose of the trailer is for a dwelling for his in-laws. The hearing ~~was~~ adjourned and the Selectmen approved the petition.

Bo Strong came in to report that work on the lagoon is ^{nearing} ~~completed~~ and for work done to date. he presented his bill. He also presented a bill from the N. H. Planning Commission for their help in preparing the Ordinance on Cluster Housing.

Janet Nixon brought in a map of their property showing a site on which they plan to build a house . This dwelling will not be cause for subdivision.

Jay Marden came in to review his properties.

The Selectmen unanimously awarded work of installing the sprinkler system at the Whipple Free Library to the low bidder, Syvertsen, Inc.

Almus Chancey, Road Agent, asked permission to haul a minimal amount of gravel from the Nellie Follansbee lot without cutting trees. Permission was granted.

Building permits were approved for Andrew Belanger and Ellsworth McIntyre.
