

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 13, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

A Trailer Hearing was held at the request of Mr. & Mrs. Real Soucy to place a temporary trailer on their property on Laurel Lane. Abutters present were Mr. & Mrs. Henry Daniels, Mr. & Mrs. Robert LaMontagne and Mr. Raymond Masson. Mr. Soucy explained he has his foundation for his house all in, and following the sale of his present dwelling in Manchester, he would like to place a trailer on his property for living purposes while building his new house. None of the abutters had any objections to this arrangement. An Agreement will be written up for signing, making sure Mr. Soucy adheres to his promise. Abutters will be notified of the outcome.

Later in the evening, the Selectmen approved the application.

Donald Byam came in to inquire about a refund due him on his 1980 taxes due to a substantial error made in computing his taxes and he was awarded an abatement for the year 1981. The Selectmen agreed to discuss the matter.

Carolyn Todd came in to discuss the curbing of the library. The question before the Board was whether to have the town Road Crew make the corrections or have the contractor make amends. The Selectmen opted to have the Road Crew do the work. The Library Trustees were in full agreement. Sel. Caldwell reported an estimate cost of \$8.00 a lineal foot. Sel. Olson stated that as of ^{June} ~~May~~ 10, architect Michael Ingram was officially dismissed from the project of the library addition.
