


NEW BOSTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Oct. 5, 2000



Treasury - \$13,165.34

Members present: Deb Keiner, Cyndie Wilson, Rebecca Balke, Betsey Dodge, Joe Nangle, and Lou Maynard;

Minutes of the Sept. meeting were read, edited and accepted.

A * T - Lots on Beard Rd. owned by Al Stevens. Will be heard at the 10/10 PB mtg at 8:00. PB has discussed limiting building on the slopes with the builder. The builder is a logger and the logging was discussed. Deb to do letter to PB with cc to Al Stevens re; a buffer and/or greenway.

Waldorf estates - JFL Enterprises; this is Phase III of Waldorf; CC met with Chris Danforth, wetland scientist, Bob Baskerville and David Walker of Bedford Design, Joe MacAlister, attorney, and Hans Hassel. They came before our board for a dredge and fill and wetlands application. The original permits had expired in 1987, and we were looking at the Storch plan from the 80's. there was some concern about the age of the map, and concerns that the Wetlands board in Concord does not have the appropriate map. We will need a map with driveway locations. Mr. Baskerville agreed to send a new map to Concord. Discussion of standard dredge and fill. The estimated total area of wetlands and all proposed work is 17,819 sq. ft.. (Area to be filled). The roadway is already stumped and cleared. Brenda, Lou and Joe did the walk. Lou made the motion to accept the D & F and send letter to state subject to new maps. The motion passed.

Footbridge - The CC has received the final bill. Brian Dorwart has checked the original contract, and signed off on the final work. Motion made and seconded to pay final bill of \$36,600.00. Dedication is scheduled for Saturday, October 28, 2000 at 10:00AM. Thank you notes will include an invitation to the dedication. Jim Carter of Stae Forest and Lands, looked at the bridge, and was pleased with the result. Betsey (?) received word that Lang Station is to be rehabilitated by the State. CC has concerns regarding the removal of trees from the front of the station. Loam is to moved, and signs to be posted. Joe to ask about signs, and Betsey to call about signs. CC thanks Willard Dodge for many hours of volunteer help. Brochures are to be worked out with Kate, Betsey and Brenda.

Quirk - Joe and Lou did an onsite at the Friendly Beaver Campground on 9/10. It has been reported that sensitive areas have been flagged. the wetlands are hard to find. The questions on flagging have not been resolved. Joe has sent a reply to the PB.
