Howard Woodbury came in with a letter from Daniel O'Shaughnessy, his attorney, relative to the Calvin Robinson property. Mr. O'Shaughnessy states it would be illegal for the Town to re-deed this property to Mr. Robinson. The Selectmen will continue to pursue the matter. They will contact Town Counsel for another opinion.

Buildings permits were awarded to EMile LaVertu and Robert McKinnon.

Roger Paradis submitted an Intent to Cut form.

Atty. James Otis returned to continue search on the Delia Siemezs property , now owned by Christine Wold.

Kerri-Ann Bowen came in to ask for monetary assistance from the town in the form of payment of rent. She is physically disabled and cannot work. She asked for help from the town temporarily so as to be eligible for food stamps and medical assistance from the State Welfare. Her appeal will be turned over to Harold Strong, the town's Welfare Officer.
