Present were Oliver Andrews, Thomas Mansfield and Betty Hooper.

August Gomes came in in regard to the preparation of the Tax Map for the State Assessors who are planning to start work next week.

Walter Leach, Jr. came in to ask the Selectmen when the town plans to finish road work on the east end of Bedford Road. They said this would be when the Road Agent finishes on the dump road.
