March 29, 1979

People who came in to discuss Current Use were Roger Gagnon, Michael Rosebury and Esther Mary Hadley. Mrs. Hadley asked the Selectmen to have the town road which travels through her New Boston (now closed subject to gates) to be closed permanently. This procedure must be handled through the people's vote at a Town Meeting.

Pistol permits were issued to Andrew Belanger and David Bowen.

A Current Use application was submitted by Everett Dicey.

A Driveway application for the Winfield Lovejoy subdivision was submitted by William Sears, Surveyer.

Members of the Recreation Commission, Sandra Gallup and Larry Daley, came in to discuss a Junior ^{SOFT} Baseball program and asked permission to use the Town Seal for a shoulder patch design.
