

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

April 5, 1979

Present were Thomas Mansfield, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper. Roland Sallada came in later.

A meeting was scheduled for 7:00 pm to meet with Ray Woolsen and Frank Flannery, officials from the Souhegan National Bank to reconsider the handling of borrowing in anticipation of taxes.

Current Use applications were submitted from Michael Rosebury and Louis Kachavos.

Building permits were issued to Bruce Merron & Richard Farrell. Mr. Wichman came in for advise on placing his land under discretionery easement. He will contact the Planning Board.

In view of a recurring problem, Roland Sallada moved that no one may dig up a town road without first obtaining permission from the Board of Selectmen. The motion was seconded by Mr. Mansfield and voted unanimously. Daniel McCreary requested permission to dig across Briar Hill for the purpose of placing water pipes. Permission granted with a letter to follow.

The Selectmen decided to tour the town checking on junk yards, trailers and bridges and railings.
