

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 17, 1979

Present were Roland Sallada, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper.

A building permit was issued to Marjorie Stier and a pistol permit was issued to Paul Wilson.

Jerry Kennedy came in to resolve the problem regarding his yield taxes. He submitted a check in payment.

Charles & Jeannette Lee came in to approach the Selectmen regarding the placing of a trailer on their land while building their house. It was explained that the Building Ordinance prohibits two dwellings on the same lot. They will try to find some legal method to accomplish their destination.

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The Selectmen met with ~~two~~ members of the Town Hall Committee. They suggested the following conditions be rectified: Urinal in Men's Room; repair emergency lights (ask the Fire Chief to check lights) Locks for upstairs doors. It was decided to ~~hire~~ hire someone to paint the upper Town Hall stair well. Also putty the windows first. It was also decided to charge a \$25 deposit for rental of the hall for auctions, receptions and fund-raising dinners. * Mary Anne Martel's term on the Committee expires, therefore Joanne Luneau's name was placed in nomination. j

Atty. Ray Burgess was asked to come in to discuss road work being done on Old County Road, a class VI road. He claimed the first person hired to clear the road was fired because of dissatisfaction. He has hired Milton Elliott to finish the job and clean up trees and rocks, leaving the road natural as much as possible.

Martha Brooks and Carolyn Todd of the Conservation Commission discussed the Calvin Robinson house which is in disreputable condition. They were concerned about what the town should do with it now that Mr. Robinson is deceased. Perhaps burn the house down?

Mrs. Brooks suggested the Commission review all other properties owned by the town to decide which to sell at auction or keep.

Mr. Farella's septic system was discussed. The Water Pollution Control Dept. of Concord has issued him an order to cease and desist continued work on the system.
