Mrs. Frank Severance came in regarding the Selectmen's order to vacate a trailer lot at Friendly Beaver Campground. She feels she can be out by September 23. There was no response from a same request to the Dion's.

Dr. Brooks came in regarding his request, as health officer, to Katherine Johnston to remove her horses from pasturing on the Halpin property abutting her property. Tom advised Dr. Brooks to contact Mr. Halpin. Regarding Everett Dicey's leach field cesspool - Dr. Brooks has received no answer for a month.

Richard Warnock submitted a driveway application and requested a renewal to his pistol permit.

Police Chief, John Ballou, discussed the Demolition Derby held at the property of Paul Buchanan on the Frankestown Turnpike without benefit of a permit. Mr. Buchanan will appear in court on Tuesday Sept. 18. Chief Ballou warned the Selectmen of a possible 'replay' at another date.
