

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

December 27, 1979

Present were Roland Sallada, Thomas Mansfield, Merrill Todd and Betty Hooper.

A representative from the Northern Allumium Co. returned to discuss storm windows for the town hall. He explained they don't make windows as large as needed on the town hall and would prepare a new estimate. (He called the next morning with the following figures: 24 windows \$73.12 each; 2 small front windows: \$68.76 each; 1 large; \$96.88 bringing the total to: \$1,989.28.)
