

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 10, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

Henry Boulanger came in for an extension of time to his trailer permit applied for and approved on March 20, 1981. A 45-day extension was granted making the inspection date on July 26.

Mr. Richard High came in asking for assistance in ~~an~~ paying his electric bill. He owes \$575.25 and the power was shut off today. The Selectmen ruled that Mr. High is to bring to this office on the first of each month the amount of \$150 to be paid toward his bill and the town will write a check in the amount of \$200 paid to the Public Service, this schedule to continue until the electric bill is paid up to date. He was also offered wood from town property for fuel which he would cut himself, to control the use of electricity for heating purposes.

The Selectmen met with members of the Playground Asso. and Police Chief Ballou to discuss the possibility ~~f~~ of conducting the July 4 celebration at the 4-H grounds to ease the congestion of traffic from the center of town. The majority ruled to continue the event in the center of town, but agreed to form a committee to try to resolve parking problems and the blocking of main roads which prohibit space to drive a fire truck or ambulance through. The Road Agent ~~and~~, Fire Chief and Police Chief will be included in the committee.

Leo Felix and Roland St. Onge, two septic service companies came in to have the Selectmen sign their licenses to serve New Boston and have permission to use the town lagoon when ready. Keys to the site and fees to be charged were discussed. These two gentlemen have viewed the area and complemented the Selectmen on its excellent engineering plans. They advised that the State will require a fence surrounding the area. The Selectmen decided to discuss the fees and will issue keys to the dump on the honor system.

Carolyn Todd and William Mulligan ~~es~~, Library Trustees, came in to report that they have heard nothing from Michael Ingram, Architect, regarding the agreement to finish the library addition. The Selectmen suggest that Carolyn try to contact Mr. Ingram and find out what his plans are.
