

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

June 24, 1982

Selectmen Olson and Mansfield present and secretary.

Mr. James Hansen came in to advise the Selectmen that he accepts their appointment to the Recreation Commission.

At 8:00, the Selectmen opened bids for replacement of the upper town

hall floor: Clo-Don (Clovis Gentlehomme)	\$6,900
Kennedy Brothers	7,200
Raymond Barss	8,050

The person whose bid is accepted will be notified by July 1.

Larry Daley asked the feasibility of using the Daniels land purchased at town meeting for Little League ball park preparation of lot to be at no cost to the town. The Selectmen will consider. Mr. Daley also asked if the town had an ordinance to disallow Video Public Arcades. He feels these Arcades are a detriment to a town. He was advised that the Selectmen could arbitrarily refuse such a permit if the needs should arise.

Fire Chief Dodge came in to discuss the problem of the installing of windows at the school building to meet State fire codes. He also discussed the alarm systems for public buildings.

Building permits were approved for Dennis Hooper, Denis Dinkel and Richard Soule.

Gravel Removal Permits were issued to C. Steven Strand and Charles H. Townes and Townes Family Trust.
