

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

July 1, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

The Selectmen met at 7:20 with the Town Hall Committee who included Howard Towne, Joanne Luneau and Betsy Moore, to review the bids for the Town Hall floor. The Selectmen asked the members for their input as to whom to award the bid. Mr. Clovis Gentilhomme was low bidder, but everyone seemed to be reluctant to elect him as no one knew the quality of his work. Betsy suggested asking Mr. ~~Gentil~~ Gentilhomme for names of people he had worked for and then calling them for recommendations. This was done immediately and Sel. Olson will do the calling. It was decided that if all recommendations were high, Mr. Gentilhomme would be awarded the project. the Selectmen will then meet with him to review the specifications. Howard Towne was elected to oversee the project as it progressed.

John Bunting came in to report on the library alarm system. He reported that the installation was excellent. A few minor things are yet to be taken care of. The Library Trustees asked if Fire Extinguishers could be installed at the library. The Selectmen voted to install three dry-chemical fire extinguishers. Regarding the new windows for the school, it was voted by the School Board members to re-write the specifications for re-bidding.

It was unanimously voted by the Selectmen to award the Fire Alarm System to the Fire House, Police Station and Town Shed to the lowest bidder who is LeBlanc Electric in the amount of \$10,200 (Art. #9).

The Selectmen agreed to honor Jacqui Gallup at Town Meeting of 1983 as being chosen Queen of the N. H. Recreation Commissions. She then was a contender in the Miss New Hampshire pageant.
