

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

Sept. 16, 1982

Present were Sel. Olson, Sel. Caldwell and secretary.

The Selectmen met with Gloria Riley at 7:30. She explained that she has been put on part-time at work (3 days a week) and is unable to handle all expenses having had car repairs and car insurance. She appealed to the Selectmen for payment of this month's rent and electric bill. They agreed.

Mr. Sarto Myre came in to discuss again the problem with the Sidney Magoon's presumably illegal septic system. He asked what action the Selectmen had taken on this case. He was advised that they had written to the State Water Pollution Control Commission for advise on how to handle the situation. We are awaiting the result of their investigation.

The Selectmen discussed rules and fees for operating our septage lagoon. They plan to meet with Mr. Felix and Mr. St. Onge next Thursday to finalize the above problems and supply them with keys to the Land Fill area.

Due to abuse of the Town Hall by private rentals, such as for private parties and weddings receptions, the Selectmen have raised the amount of the security deposit to \$125.00. New rental fees will be decided upon following a meeting with the Selectmen and the Town Hall Committee.
