SPECIAL MEETING

The three Selectmen met at 6:30 pm on September 21 at the Selectmen's Office with Town Counsel, David L. Nixon, for the purpose of getting a ~~clearer~~ clearer understanding of the Town Zoning Ordinance relative to acreage per house lot and number of dwellings allowed per house lot. The case in question was the matter of Mr. & Mrs. Sidney Magoon remodeling their garage for living quarters for their son and wife. Mr. Nixon specifically stated they were in violation of the Ordinance and should have made application for variance.

Sel. Olson asked if the town could enforce a 2-family dwelling per house lot as worded in the Ordinance. Mr. Nixon feels the Ordinance reads properly and would be defensible in court.

Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Thompson came in to apply for a trailer permit to house their son and his wife, the son not being well physically. They have found a trailer that suits the situation perfectly and hope to move it into place as soon as possible. A Trailer Hearing has been scheduled for Thursday October 7 at 7:30 pm.

The Selectmen then helped with Current Use records in the preparation of the 1982 Blotter Book.
