

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

September 23, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

Rep. Sallada came in to alert the Selectmen in regard to a new State law on Arcades RSA 31:41D and Pin Ball Machines 31:42 which would prohibit having more than one in a town. He advised placing an article in the Town Meeting Warrant to accept this law in the town of New Boston, being as some towns have had problems in these areas which seem to draw undesirable attendance.

Mr. Sallada next brought to the attention of the Selectmen that an old map of the town was discovered in the Library safe (estimated year - 1700's) and asked that the Selectmen consider having it refurbished and framed at a maximum cost of \$462. The Selectmen will consider the matter.

The Selectmen met at 8:00 pm with Mr. Roland St. Onge, Leo Felix and Charles Koenig, septage collectors, who will be using the New Boston lagoon which is now open. They were authorized keys to the gate of the Sanitary Land Fill for the convenience of getting to the area when needed. Distribution of Land-fill keys ~~were~~ also went to the Custodian, Road Agent and two keys to the Fire Chief. A fee of \$10 will be charged from the three septage collectors for each time they dump a load. The honor system will be used.

Arnold Byam came in to reserve the town hall for a Jack & Jill party and wedding reception. He was advised that the deposit is now \$125 and no amount has been set for the rent as yet. The Selectmen will meet with the Town Hall Committee for a decision and he will be notified.

Marian Chittim came in to discuss a problem regarding acreage of her property. She claims 85 acres, but Robert Todd, surveyor, prepared her Current Use map and applied for only 62 acres. She fears, as an abutter, he will claim these 20 acres as his own. The Selectmen allowed the extra 20 acres to her, feeling the evidence was apparent.
