

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

October 7, 1982

Three Selectmen and secretary present.

Mr. & Mrs. Lawrence Paro brought in a subdivision plan of land which was an exchange with Mary Bunting Smith from the lot they had previously obtained a building permit. The Selectmen will allow their permit of April, 1981 to cover their plans on the exchange property being as the new site is directly across the road and their building plans remain the same.

Hall Brothers Construction applied for and received a building permit to build a new house on Route 136 for David Merrill. However, as the Selectmen reviewed the plans later, ~~there~~ there seemed to be some discrepancies per the building ordinance, therefore the Selectmen will look into this matter.

A Trailer Hearing was held at the request of Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Thompson to connect a trailer to their home for a dwelling for their son and wife. The applicants and son and daughter-in-law were the only ones present. Sel. Mansfield moved the trailer be approved. Sel. Caldwell seconded the motion and the motion passed.

William O. Mason came in to discuss the amount of acreage on a piece of his property which he plans to sell. He produced a deed and a surveyor's map of the property. He asked the Selectmen to verify the amount of acreage. They felt that he should accept the certified surveyor's acreage.

George St. John (Sr.) applied for, and received, a refund for last year's taxes as he was taxed for too many acres.

Mrs. Malandrino called by telephone just to notify the Selectmen of her plans to settle an old problem with Paul Dionne who has strung barbed wire on her trees for a corral for his horses. She has asked him to remove the wire and nails as it was damaging her trees. He has not done so. She will call him tomorrow giving him one-half hour to conform to her demands, after which, if it does not get done, she will personally remove the wire. She also reported two dogs in her neighborhood that are sadly abused. She has reported this case to Nancy Strong, dog officer.

Alan LaPenn came in to find out the status of his road. He claims to have been robbed and harassed many times and would like to put a fence across the entrance.

Building permits were issued to Normand LaMarche and James Skinner.
A Pistol Permit renewal was issued to Timothy Ainsworth.
