

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

October 28, 1982

Selectmen and secretary present.

Sel. Olson and Sel. Caldwell met at 7:00 pm with Mona Winslow. She informed the Selectmen that her husband, John, has moved out and has left her. She needs financial aid in the interim of receiving County Welfare. The Selectmen agreed to pay her Mortgage and electric bill.

Building permits were ~~approved~~ approved for Mr. & Mrs. Mansperger and Mr. & Mrs. Gary Lawrence.

Scott McQuade, Library Trustee, came in to discuss some of the remaining problems with the Library addition. He again mentioned the front doors, which are not the ones specified in the plans. He also mentioned the roof not adequately insulated and the curbing not corrected. Sel. Olson informed him that the appropriation for the addition has long since been exhausted plus a great over-expenditure, therefore there are no more funds available and he expects the Trustees will have to ~~fix~~ live with these few problems unless they had the courage to go before Town Meeting and ask for more funds. Sel. Olson did agree that the curbing would be done by the town road crew. Mr. McQuade asked if the Selectmen wanted an engineer to inspect the results of the project. They felt there would be nothing gained by this and furthermore, the town cannot afford this extra expense.

Mr. McQuade asked if the Selectmen have put the town oil supply out for bid yet. The answer was no, but they will take care of the matter soon.

John Bunting, Asst. Fire Chief, came in to discuss the Building Permit from Donald Grosso for the building of a Post Office on his property. The Fire Dept. would like to write him a letter making suggestions to help him with future structures in regard to fire codes. The Selectmen agreed.

Verification was received from the Dept. of Revenue regarding the tax rate. It was established at \$28.80 per M. Adjourned at 11:30
