

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 28, 1988

Present were Selectmen Olson, Mansfield, Dodge and secretary.

- 7:15 Selectmen met with secretary discussing weekly business.
- 7:30 Lee Murray came in with Charles Byam to inquire about the truck drivers position. Charles Byam was hired as a truck driver starting March 29, 1988 at \$6.43 per hour (Step I). He will receive Step II in sixty (60) days and Step III at the end of the year.
- 8:12 Kris Stewart came in to inquire about the requirements to obtain a gravel permit. He will be back with the necessary paper work when he is ready for a public hearing.
- 8:45 Mike Richard was in to discuss hazardous waste day which is scheduled for September 24, 1988. He is looking into the possibilities of using the playground for the collection site.
- 8:55 Michael Stickney was asked to come in to sign the release of liability for building on a class six (6) road. He refused to sign the agreement which had been verbally agreed upon with him prior to issuing him a building permit. He felt others on the same road was not required to sign so he was not going to sign. The matter is still under dispute.
- 9:30 The Library Trustees were in to discuss the possibilities of the librarian receiving health insurance. Selectmen felt full coverage should be offer to full-time employees. The trustees were willing to increase her hours to thirty (30) and paid 85% of the health insurance.
- 10:15 Arthur Martin and Rocco Civiello were in to let the Selectmen know they are ready to upgrade Hopkins Road. Selectman Dodge will bring this topic up at next Planning Board meeting.

Selectmen signed checks and reviewed weekly mail.
