

Selectmen's Meeting

May 2, 1988

Present were Selectmen Olson, Dodge, Mansfield and secretary.

7:15 Lee Murray feels that some of the driveways on Joe English Road needs to be changed because of the road construction. Selectmen will go on location Thursday, May 5 at 6:00 PM to inspect driveways.

7:45 Harold Walker was in by request of the Selectmen to discuss his duties at the Landfill and Town Hall. He was informed that he was employed by the Town of New Boston and not his brother. Selectmen explained that if an accident happened his brother would not be covered by Town insurance.

8:00 Brent Armstrong representing 4-H Foundation asked the Selectmen to review their proposed gravel application.

8:45 Douglas Clark came in to request that his temporary trailer permit be issued as a permanent trailer permit. He has the trailer on cement blocks, has installed a septic system and well. Selectmen will make arrangements with him to inspect location. The Selectmen want to review his property with the building inspector to see if his trailer meets the Boca Code.

9:00 John Ballou was in and the Selectmen discuss with him the intersection of Bedford Road, Cemetery Road and Meetinghouse Hill Road. Chief Ballou recommended a three (3) way stop at the intersection. However, he was willing to try a stop sign at Cemetery Road and Bedford Road with a yield sign on Meetinghouse Hill Road.

Selectmen voted to establish an ordinance to have a stop sign on Cemetery Road and Bedford Road with a yield sign on Meetinghouse Hill Road adjacent to the Howard Kane resident. Selectmen voted unanimously on this ordinance. This ordinance is in effect immediately.

Selectmen signed checks and reviewed weekly mail.
