

Selectmen's Meeting

May 16, 1988

Present were Selectmen Mansfield, Dodge and secretary.

7:25 Lee Murray and Harold Strong came in to discuss upgrading Hopkins Road. Selectmen, Road Agent and Chairman of the Planning Board agreed to meet on location (Wed., May 18, 1988 at 7:30 am) with Arthur Martin and Robert Todd to determine width of road.

Selectmen agreed to meet with John Young on location (Tues., May 17, 1988 at 7:30pm) to determine the amount of land needed to widen Beard Road.

Road Agent and Chairman of the Planning Board discuss with Selectmen when would the top coat be put on new roads. They were in agreement that the top coat would go down one (1) year from the base coat.

8:15 Richard Messina was in to see if there was a possibility to use his gravel to upgrade Clark Hill Road. Selectmen will discuss this with Road Agent and Planning Board to see if this would be agreeable. Selectmen would have to approve the person Richard Messina plans to hire to do the stumping. Selectmen will be in touch with Richard Messina.

8:40 Ernie Thibeault gravel hearing. Abutter August Gomes Jr., interested party Herbert Scott. Selectmen read Conservation comments. Mr. Thibeault said he would be paving the entrance to his pit. There was some discussion on August Gomes Jr. using the same entrance. However, Mr. Gomes rather use his own entrance. Mr. Thibeault would be willing to donate a certain amount of money for a culvert and paving on Lyndeboro Road bridge. The Selectmen will discuss bond for road damage and size of trucks that will be hauling gravel. Mr. Thibeault and Mr. Hill hauls gravel out of Tingley's pit on Route 13. However, he will not haul gravel out of both pits at the same time. Mr. Thibeault expects a decision within ten (10) days of the hearing (5/26/88).

Selectmen signed checks and review weekly correspondence.
