

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

September 19, 1988

Present were Selectmen Olson, Dodge and secretary.

- 7:30 Frank and Diane Crawford came in to discuss extending their temporary trailer permit. Mr. & Mrs. Crawford intentions to build a garage before winter and continue in the spring to build their house. At this time the Crawford's are not interested in a permanent trailer permit. Their extension on the temporary trailer permit was granted until 9/19/89.
- 7:50 Ray Nolan and Leo Dumonte of Ducor Development, Inc. came in to review upgrading Wilson Hill Road. Ducor Development would like to gravel the present road to the point where emergency vehicles could pass. They would like to relocate Wilson Hill Road instead of bringing Wilson Hill Road up to class 5. Selectmen Olson and Dodge along with Planning Board Chairman, Harold Strong explained the procedures for upgrading class 6 roads. Further discussion with both boards for upgrading will follow.
- 8:55 Ernie Thibeault came in to discuss signing his gravel permit and installing a culvert on Lyndeboro Road. Selectmen will make an amendment to his gravel permit to use 18 wheelers at 15 min intervals on a trial basis subject to review upon any complaints from the public. The permit will be signed upon receiving a letter of credit.
