Lorraine Barney, Walter Leach Jr and Charles Carr were in to further discuss Lorraine Barney's property extending into the Town right-of-way. This has been an on-going issue and the results were that documents were signed by all parties involved that would for all intents and purposes give Mrs. Barney clear title to her land and would give the Town land to make the necessary road changes.
