Minutes Selectmen Meeting - Dec. 12, 1988

Present were Chmn. Theodore Olson, Sel. Willard Dodge and Sel. Thomas Mansfield. Notes were kept by Sel. Dodge and recorded below in the absence of Secretary Linda Sizemore due to illness.

The Board met with Craig Cassarino at 7:10 pm from RDCA (Recycling Corp. of America) and Ron Cook from Sanco, Inc. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a proposal whereby New Boston would contract with RDCA to handle New Boston's recyclable solid waste and with Sanco to handle our landfillable solid wastes. Proposal needs further study see Sanco proposal dated 12/12/88.

The Board then met with Tim Cady, Engineer from GZA to discuss the bids submitted and opened on Dec. 7, 1988 (see minutes attached) to do a project related to the closing of the Landfill. Each bidder was invited in discuss his submitted bid.

Bud Scott was the first one to come in to discuss his proposal to shape and place 12' of fill material on the Town Landfill. His bid was \$57,100.00, he estimated that 6000 yards of fill would be needed to cover after shaping and would haul this fill in from Scott and Sons gravel pit. He did not intend to use on-site material. A Letter of Credit would be needed.

Don Wheeler and Joe Conway came in with Don's bid of \$88,998.00. He estimated 9,537 yards of cover material and 1000 yards of fill material all to be obtained on-site. Discussion revealed that he would charge approximately \$1.00 per yard over and above the bid for all material tranferred from either side of the landfill as cover. Providing a bond would not be a problem.

Paul Boisvert was in representing Boisvert & Sons. Their bid was \$86,517.00. His estimate for subgrade fill material was not more than 1700 yards and the cover material to be 9900 yards. Material to be used would be on-site and a Letter of Credit would be available.

Steve and Dave Elliott were in with their bid of \$89,620.00. They estimated 10,000 yards would be necessary to cover the landfill with enough material on-site to do the job. Their bid included preparation of a one acre stump dump area (about \$3500.) to be used not only for this project but future road jobs also. ( A stump dump area of sufficient size to contain stumps related to this project was a necessary part of the bid.) A Letter of Credit would be available.

At the conclusion of the interviews, the Administrative Asst. was instructed to advise Scott that he had the bid providing he gets bank approval on the Letter of Credit by Wed. noon and has the Letter in hand by noon on Friday. This call was placed by Sandra Gendron Tues., Dec. 13 at 9:00 am.


Bids were opened at 2:45 pm which had been submitted for the advertised project at the Landfill.
