8:10 Don Grosso was in with regards to other commercial buildings in New Boston (ie: Sizemore). He was concerned with what boards Mr. Sizemore was going to go before and if he has done anything with regards of above. Mr. Sizemore has been in to get the paperwork for site plan review but that is as far as things have gotten. Mr. Grosso's second concern was assessing commercial haulers a tipping fee. His main concern was that we were not getting other towns trash, so by assessing the commercial hauler, he felt that this might help.

The letter regarding Mr. Mike Conroy (PSE) was talked about and the Selectmen wants the secretary to call and make an appointment for Mr. Conroy to come in and discuss this with them on the 26th of June.

The issue was brought up by the secretary about the pigeons in the clock tower. The gentleman from the clock company was in last week to check out the clock and get it running. He did some work on the clock but said he was unable to start the clock due to the amount of pigeons up there. He suggested that we get an exterminator to get rid of the pigeons before they ruin the clock. Mr. Dodge said that he would go up and take a look at the situation tomorrow and we would go from there.

Chief Ballou was in and requested to work additional hours on duty patrolling because he was leaving his full time employment. He was granted the approval for additional hours with the understanding that this will have no bearing of the outcome of the full time police chief duty.

Chief Ballou was also talking about the 4th of July and that the Playground Association was thinking about having an outside dance but he has not heard any more from Holly Bowen about police duty. The secretary called Holly for a couple of issues regarding the 4th of July, first they have decided not to have an outside dance and second the insurance policy for fireworks, which she said Wayne Daniels has taken care of, but he still has not given us a copy so that we can issue the permit.

The Selectmen wanted the secretary to contact the members of the Road Committee to meet in the parking lot at 6PM on the 26th of June to go and look at McCurdy Road on site. The secretary is working on contacting the members.
