

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - October 9, 1989

Present for the meeting were Selectmen Mansfield, Dodge and Johnston. Sandra Gendron took minutes. Selectman Mansfield could only stay for a short time due to a meeting he was scheduled to attend in Weare. Decisions were made on two matters remaining from the previous week. It was decided that Mr. & Mrs Apt, River Road could replace their existing mobile home with a new one as long as it came no closer to River Road than the current home and encroached no closer on the side bound than the existing home. This would probably limit them to a 60' home and if they wished to purchase something larger they would have to request a special exception from the ZBA. The Apts' were contacted and told of this decision and a proposed plan was given to the Building Department to insure the decision of the Board of Selectmen was adhered to.

The Selectmen discussed the proposed "home business" application of Kenneth Barss, Sr., Mont Vernon Road and decided that the criteria for a "home business" was present and Ken was called to sign the letter of intent as the owner of the property and the "home business" application which he did and copies of the paperwork were forwarded to the Planning Board for Non-Residential Site-Plan Review.

Chief of Police John Ballou and Road Agent Lee Murray were in to discuss the location and placement of 25 mph signs on the various roads in town. These signs can legally be placed after Jan. 1, 1990 and Lee would like to get as many posts as possible placed before the ground freezes this winter. Because there are a limited number of signs there was discussion on priority roads. Selectman Dodge felt that paved roads should receive first priority contending that in his opinion all dirt roads should be 25 mph both for safety and maintenance reasons. Roads that came under discussion were Old Coach, Clark Hill, Meetinghouse Hill, Molly Stark, Hooper Hill, Cemetery, Bog, Christie, McCurdy, Joe English, Beard, Tucker Mill and Bunker Hill. Lee will start in Town and work his way out placing as many posts as he has signs available to accommodate.

There being no other business to conduct checks were signed and mail was reviewed. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 10:00 pm.
