Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

March 10, 1997

A regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Goodin.

Selectman Carlstrom made a motion to accept the Selectmen's Meeting minutes from March 3, 1997. Chairman Goodin seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Carlstrom made a motion to accept the Selectmen's Meeting minutes from March 10, 1997. Selectman Pimenta seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board again discussed the possibility of keeping the Transfer Station open on Town Meeting day. It was felt that Saturday is the busiest day of the week and therefore it is necessary to keep the facility open on Town and School Meeting days. Also, it was felt that insufficient advance notice could be given as of this date to close the Transfer Station with such short notice.

Mr. Selig informed the Board of Selectmen that John Winslow was again questioning the Town's wrecker policy for inclusion on the Police Department Towing List. The Board felt that Mr. Winslow should be sent a copy of the policy and no more. If Mr. Winslow has further questions regarding this subject, he should meet directly with the Board of Selectmen.

The Board reviewed the 1997 Town Warrant in preparation for Town Meeting.


At 8:30 p.m., the Board of Selectmen traveled to the New Boston Central School to set up voting booths for tomorrow's Town Meeting Election Day.
