New Boston Transfer Station / New Boston Central School
Recycling Program for Municipal Departments


The topic of recycling within the New Boston town Departments is being addressed to see if there is any way to insure the mandatory recycling policy is being adhered to. There is currently no program in place. Each department has been managing its own trash and recycling. For each department to bring recyclables to the recycling center may not be cost effective. Some departments have contracted dumpsters to handle trash disposal.

The New Boston School Recycling Program is very successful and a low cost easy to manage solution. Every Thursday a designated employee brings the truck to the Transfer Station and recyclable materials are off loaded and processed. The Student Counsel receives a check when the recyclables are sold.

My proposal would be to have the New Boston Central School Student Counsel send a letter to all departments asking for their cooperation in recycling and then the departments would be provided a recycling tote and instructions on how to recycle. Thursdays the recyclables would be picked up by the Green Machine. Revenues from the sale of the materials would benefit the New Boston Central School. Last year a new water fountain was purchase and installed.

With all departments recycling and having the materials picked up, this will assure the ordinance is being observed. This will also save money allowing smaller dumpsters to handle the trash.
