RFP Municipal Solid Waste Disposal

The New Boston board of Selectmen are requesting proposals for the disposal approximately 900 tons of residentially generated solid waste *delivered to you facility Starting *January 1st 2016*. New Boston transfer Station is a residential drop off facility with mandatory recycling in place and allow minimal non-burnable materials into the waste stream. We do not allow commercial dumping at our facility.

Bids should be for a minimum of 3 and up to 5 years. Depending on the contract pricing New Boston will entertain an extended contract. CPI should not be a part of contract pricing structure.

New Boston generates approximately 215 tons of Construction Debris and will consider contract pricing on material **delivered to your facility. Demolition pricing will not affect MSW contract award and shall be a separate contract.

New Boston will award contract based on what is best for the town, taking into consideration logistics, including wait times, ease of operation and contract pricing. All interested parties are welcome and encouraged to visit the New Boston Transfer Station to assist in the RFP process.

Please include scope of service, verification of insurance, operation permits and any policies pertaining to materials accepted and requirements of private haulers accessing your facility.

Bids must be submitted no later than 2 PM on Wednesday September 16,2015. Any bids arriving after this time will not be considered * Bids will be opened and read aloud at 2:00pm***

The contract award will be addressed at the regular Selectman's meeting on September 21, 2015.

Disposal Facility Requirements

Wheelabrator's Concord, New Hampshire energy-from-waste facility will be the designated disposal facility for the Town's municipal solid waste disposal. Located in Penacook, New Hampshire, the Wheelabrator Concord energy-from-waste facility provides dependable, environmentally safe disposal of municipal solid waste for more than two dozen communities in southern and central New Hampshire, while generating clean renewable electricity for sale to the local utility. Owned and operated by Wheelabrator, the facility processes up to 500 tons per day of municipal solid waste. The facility has an electric generating capacity of 14,000 kilowatts; the equivalent of supplying the electrical needs of 17,000 New Hampshire homes.

Wheelabrator Concord has the ability to accept deliveries between 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, and Saturday 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Wheelabrator Concord is capable of accepting all processible municipal solid waste collected and managed by the Town. The facility was designed and constructed to allow for safe and efficient queuing, weighing, unloading, screening, and vehicle departure to assure the use of the facility by the Town.


Pricing


