Hi Wayne,

I beg you for some of your time and advice. This is about a plan that Jay Marden described to me and also asked me to provide services, free, to complete the work. Jay has asked me to help him with replacing the road side property marker, common with the church property and the station property, with a stone that he has purchased. He showed me a picture of it and it appears to be about 3 feet tall and it has a symbol cut into one surface, which he says has some religious meaning. He said he and a crew will help and he has asked me to insure that the stone is placed precisely on the corner point. Has Jay contacted the Fire Wards to request permission to set this bound?

Jay has also asked me to set a second similar stone in place of the granite bound now occupying that corner of Church property common with Parker's land. I called Randy and asked him if Jay has contacted him and I was told that he had not been asked permission.

In giving thought to what Jay proposes I am feeling an ethical twing. Furthermore any markers that are replaced in this manner should be shown on a revised property plan and the plan recorded at the Hills. Cty. Register Of deeds office.  
He has not asked Randy's permission yet.

Would you present this to the Fire Wards and ask them to consider this for me please? I would be willing to speak to the FWs about this if you think that would be the proper approach (I do not mean to burden you).
