

# Action Items from the Town Administrator

## July 15, 2013

1. **Riverdale Road Bridge Engineering update**- Contract signed and forwarded to Hoyle –Tanner. Attached update re: Estimate. DOT approves contract and pricing.

**Update-**

(From Matt Low of Hoyle-Tanner)--NH Division of Historical Resources is now involved. Technically, this is mitigation which is normally required by NHDHR when there is an Adverse Effect on Historic Properties”. We don’t have that here-yet-however, NHDHR keeps dangling the fact that the nearby farmstead might be historic. If we stand our ground on tinting, the next likely directive will be an Individual Inventory Form on the farmstead to determine the historic significance.
