UNIVERSAL WASTE ONLY

1. **Used Oil for recycle.** - Residential generated motor oil, hydraulic oil and transmission fluid, no limit.
2. **Waste Oil for recycle.** - Residential generated oil, contaminated with water or anti-freeze, **5 gallon limit.**
3. **Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Florescent lamps for recycle.**
4. **Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Automotive batteries for recycle, THIS IS A FEE ITEM.**
5. **Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Anti-freeze for recycle, 4 gallon limit.**
6. **Rechargeable batteries for recycle, see Attendant.**


MISSION STATEMENT

RECYCLE BY THE NUMBER

1 GLASS Anything that shatters!

GREEN, CLEAR, BROWN, FROSTED, BLUE, CERAMIC, MIRRORS, PLATES, CUPS, GLASSES AND WINDOW GLASS REMOVED FROM THE FRAMES. (NO WINDSHIELDS, PLEASE)

2 ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS (only)

3 TIN CANS

PET FOOD, DRY PAINT, FOIL ITEMS AND EMPTY AEROSOL CANS.

4 CARD BOARD

ANY CLEAN, DRY, BROKEN DOWN CARDBOARD
ALL PRINTED, COLORED AND SHINY CARDBOARD ACCEPTED

5 NEWSPAPER - INCLUDES INSERTS

6 MIXED PAPER - IF IT RIP'S or TEAR'S

ALL CLEAN PAPER, JUNK MAIL, MAGAZINES, PHONE BOOKS, CEREAL BOXES, EGG CARTONS, AND FOOD BOXES. *Keep shredded paper in bag and toss in window.*
(NO CHRISTMAS WRAP PAPER OR FOIL LINED ITEMS)

7 HDEP #2 OPAQUE OR SOLID COLOR PLASTIC

PLEASE REMOVE CAPS FROM BOTTLES. Bottle shape only!

8 PETE #1 CLEAR OR SEE-THRU PLASTIC

PLEASE REMOVE CAPS FROM BOTTLES. Bottle shape only!

1) New Boston has a **mandatory** Town recycling policy, approved by Town vote in 1993. Your trash may be inspected to ensure compliance. Your access to the facility to deposit your trash and recyclables could be revoked if you do not adhere to this mandatory recycling policy.

2) New Boston's Solid Waste is transported to an incinerator for disposal. Please, **DO NOT** place any item into your trash that will not burn. (Metal, dirt, rocks, glass, demolition, fiberglass, roofing, drywall, automotive parts, yard waste, carpeting, ect.)

3) Chemicals, Paints of ANY KIND, pesticides or ANY Hazardous Material CANNOT be left at the Transfer Station. Please see manager for proper disposal procedure

4) Residential fee based items may be paid for by check OR cash. (Receipts will be given for ALL transactions)

5) Residential Brush 5 inches in diameter or less. 5 pickup truck loads per year. No treated wood or yard waste. Forest clean up material is not permitted.

6) Fee based items can be paid for by cash or check. Receipts are required for all transactions. **C.O.D. ONLY.**
(Sorry no Debit or Credit cards)

\$150.00 FINE FOR ILLEGAL DUMPING

THE RULES AND POLICIES FOR USE OF THE TRANSFER STATION ARE SET BY THE STATE AND THE TOWN. THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN ENDORSES THE ENFORCEMENT OF THESE POLICIES. THE ATTENDANTS ONLY ENFORCE THESE POLICIES. *ALL RESIDENTS MUST FOLLOW THE ESTABLISHED GUIDELINES*

Tires up to 16" - \$2.00, tires 16" to 24" - \$15.00,

Tires with rims \$1.00 additional

Unacceptable items: Loader tires.

Freon Items

Refrigerators - Freezers - Dehumidifiers

Air Conditioners - \$10.00.

Propane Tanks

Tanks up to 20 lbs - \$1.00,

Tanks 20 lbs to 30 lbs - \$20.00.

Televisions/Monitors

Computer Monitors - \$5.00, Televisions - \$10.00.

Electronic items -\$3.00 , Microwaves -\$5.00

Batteries (Vehicle) - \$1.00
