RR Footbridge - Brenda is working on the Warrant Article for the \$20,000.00 to be advanced to the CC to enable the group to start the work on the bridge. The Warrant Article will be presented for a vote in March, 2000.

CC received letter from Ms. Lyons asking for a Fall progress report.

Juniper Hill - Mr. Peter Schauer and Brian Holt presented their maps at the meeting. CC and the two soil scientists discussed the wetlands maps, and told us that the wetlands application must now be renewed. CC received copy of letter of violations on present phase from Comm. Varney of DES.;

The road is private, and not yet accepted by the town. Discussion of the different impact areas and how the erosion would be controlled with rip-rap and mulching. We were told that 26,000 sq. ft. of land would be impacted. Note to file: Attorney Jed Callen is representing Mrs. Byam. Site walk to be done on Jan. 9, 2000 at 8:00AM (Ray and Joe).

CIP - REPP mtg. Jan. 11, 2000 at 8:30; the first 35,000 is tied up in a restricted account. A Petition was circulated to raise and appropriate \$40,000 over and above the CIP amount of \$35,000. Waiting for Marvel easement(?)

Forestry, FLESA and CC - Brandy would like to meet with the 3 groups for information on land acquisition and other related issues. Deb and Cyndie to attend.

Piscataquog River - Pis. River Management Plan - Mike Richards has asked if any comments of plan prior to public hearing to accept plan.

Mill Pond Cons. Area - Atty. Jed Callen is representing W. Morrissey, and Jed has sent a 4 page statement to the town. Atty. Nixon is responding to the statement, and referring to the RSA's for verification.

Fundraisers - Waiting for student artists to be commissioned.

Forestry Meeting - Cyndie attended Forestry meeting and met later with Jonathan Brooks about a pamphlet about the Town Forests and conservation areas. Discussion of ideas for brochures to

hopefully be distributed to townspeople. Jon to work on layout. Discussion of work done by UNH students and students from Antioch College. Consensus among members present that profit from T-shirt sales may be used toward these brochures.

A & T - Bog Road, Deed received. Land is at Map 9, Lot 54, book 6184 and Page 1652, 33.41 acres. Cyndie to do letter of thanks.

Peter Herbert - Waiting to hear from Selectmen on status of Herbert land on route 13.

Todd Family Trust - The Todd family is deeding 29 acres of land in the great Meadow to the town. Discussion of survey, and CC decided it would be best to have it surveyed properly, rather than rely on "stakes and stones in the brook" as a boundary line.
