

What Not To Bring:

Ammunition, Prescription or Controlled Drugs, Explosives, Shock Sensitive Materials, Radioactive Materials, Gas Cylinders (compressed), Infectious or Biologically Active Materials, Unknown Materials. **These materials will not be accepted.**

*****Attention Please*** 10 GALLON LIMIT**

NO LATEX PAINT: Latex Paint is **NOT** hazardous – line a cardboard container with a plastic bag, pour the paint into the plastic lined container and allow to air dry. When dry, tie the plastic bag closed and place in the hopper. Recycle the metal paint cans in Bin #3.

REMEMBER: Residential-generated used motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, batteries and fluorescent light bulbs are accepted year-round.

Commercial-generated materials; contact Clean Harbors at 1-781-849-1800 to arrange prior permission to drop off hazardous materials at cost.

NEVER MIX CHEMICALS!! Keep the product in the original container, with the label intact. If the label is missing, and you are sure of the contents, label it. If you are not sure of the contents, the Chemist on site will make the determination. If the original container is broken or leaking, place it inside a second container made of the same material. **Always** wear gloves and goggles when handling leaky containers. Keep chemicals away from heat or open flame. **Keep all chemicals away from children and pets, and handle with care!!**
