

SELECTMEN'S MEETING

August 31, 1978

Present were Oliver Andrews, Roland Sallada and Betty Hooper.

Atty. Daniel W. O'Shaughnessy and Howard Robinson came in to discuss the purchase of the Calvin Robinson property. Roland explained that the presiding Selectmen in 1971, (Sept.) namely: Roland Sallada, Harold Strong and Walter Kirsch) had an agreement with Calvin Robinson that he could continue to live in his camp and pay rent to the town, the rent to be accrued toward the re-purchase of the property and be deeded back to him. On receipt of the balance due (\$1,778.65), the ~~Selectmen~~ town will present Calvin Robinson a Selectmen*s Deed .

Roland Lemire came to ask permission to cut lumber at the dump. He said there probably is about 25,000 board feet. He offered \$45 per thousand to cut and pile brush. Selectman Andrews will contact Mr. Roger Paradis for a bid and the cutting will be offered to the highest bidder.

Mr. Herbert Stains, the new owner of the Roger Nekton property came in for information regarding the classification of his road. He would like the town to plow this winter. Roland suggested Mr. Stains prepare an article for the Warrant for the March twon meeting requesting the road be accepted as a town road and re-opened. Mr. Stains was given permission to cut branches and brush along the road.

Atty. James Otis of Milford, N. H. came in for information regarding the location of the Delia Siemezs property now owned by Christine Wold who is selling.

Ivan Byam came in to apply for the job of Town Hall custodian if the position ever is open. He is starting a Custodial Service.

The Town Hall Committee held a meeting in the Conference Room. They are setting up a new charge system.
