

Present were Chairman Willard Dodge, Selectmen Mansfield and Olson. Secretary Sizemore unable to take notes as she was occupied with updating the computer with tax information so selectman Olson took notes for the meeting. Meeting commenced at 7:30 PM.

7:45 - Jeff Katz came in to discuss the transfer of the Town Land purchased from Andy Belanger of River Road by the Piscataquog Water Shed Association and transferred to the Town of New Boston. The cost of the Title Search to be completed by the Town Counsel and the money would come from legal fees. Information would be sent from the Town requesting the Title Search to be completed by the Town Att.

7:54 - Paul Stanger came in to request a Temp. appointment of Carol Katz to the Trustees of the Library to replace Paul Savoy who is unable to complete his term of office. A motion was made by Mr. Mansfield and seconded by Mr. Olson to that effect appointing Mrs. Katz to fill the remainder of this years term until Town Meeting of 1988. A vote was taken and the vote was unanimous.

8:22 - The Gravel Hearing continued from October 5, 1987 and October 12, 1987 - RE: Herbert A. Scott - Mr. Scott did not appear at the appointed time and the board and abutters waited 22 minutes but he did not show nor did anyone appear in his behalf. A motion from the Chairman was asked to be made to cancel the Public Hearing because he did not appear. Motion was made by Mr. Mansfield and seconded by Mr. Olson to cancel this Public Hearing concerning the expansion of Herbert A. Scott Gravel Permit to 150,000 yards. Mr. Hebert wanted to make sure that when and if another hearing occurred that the abutters would be present and the board agreed. A vote was taken by the board on the above motion and the vote was unanimous. Abutters present were Armand Hebert, Roberta Hebert, Lionel Chancey and Norma Chancey.

8:39 - A discussion was held on the Transfer Station by the Selectmen - The plan from M&M Equipment - ie; Leon Giles is not ready for layout - What we have is a site plan and we now have to spend money or the possibility exists of approx. (\$1500-\$2000) to lay out the site plan. We were told by M&M Equipment Co. to put this plan out to bid when in fact it was not ready to bid on. - A discussion ensued to go ahead with Edelweiss Corp. and let them lay it out. They would do the actual survey and set the markers and grade stakes if required in order to accomplish the job. A phone call was made to Edelweiss Corp. Resolved to work out a plan between Engineer Leon Giles and the engineer from Edelweiss Corp.

9:50 - Weekly mail was reviewed and checks were signed.

10:30 - Discussion of Duke's Junk Yard ensued and what to do about it. It was decided to refer the matter to the Town Attorney.

11:15 - Meeting adjourned.
