Selectman's Policy

Temporary Signs on Town Property

1. This policy applies to all Town owned property to include the public ways and associated rights of way. Not included are the properties owned by the New Boston School District
2. Applications for signs should be submitted to the Building Office 30 days in advance of the requested display date.
3. Applications shall be processed like any other sign permit by the Building Inspector. In addition, the Board of Selectmen may be called upon for final disposition of an application.
3. Applications will be accepted from all Town Departments and their subsidiaries.
4. Applications will be accepted from bona fide, non profit organizations that directly and proximately benefit a reasonable number of New Boston Residents.
5. Directional signs may only be in place on the day of the event.
6. Signs may be in place a max. of 14 days. Exceptions may be made for Official Town Departments that have a closely spaced series of events.
7. Signs at the intersection of Rt. 77 and Rt. 13, in the triangle, are restricted to 6Sq.Ft. For safety reasons there may only be two signs at any given time.
8. Signs shall not obscure sight distances for motorists or pedestrians. Lot line setbacks, size and height restrictions established for permanent signs should be adhered to for the applicable zoned district.
