2013 Injury Treatment Outcomes

Bedford Occupational Acute Care of Manchester, Nashua and Salem, is pleased to publish our injury treatment statistical outcomes for the year of 2013! This year, our data includes results from all three of our occupational health care clinics. As you know, in June 2013 we opened our Nashua clinic and officially merged Salem Occupational Acute Care with BOAC extending our coverage making BOAC accessible to all employers in southern NH. While providing exceptional medical care to your injured employees is one of our most important goals, we also strive to provide our medical care at reasonable rates – thus we pay very close attention to our outcomes, measuring them monthly, quarterly and annually.

In 2013, BOAC served over 1200 injured workers and our injury treatment outcomes are as follows:

- Number of Visits to case closure: Average 3
- Days from initial treatment to discharge: 19
- Percentage of cases with lost time: Less than 1%
- Average cost per case \$734.41
