#### Current and upcoming road work -

Focus has been on Old Coach Road. The status is as follows: we have changed a couple of drain pipes, completed shoulder, slope and ditch work. Today was reclaiming to be followed by grading and paving. Next on our agenda is to wash the bridges so that we can treat them (concrete sealer. Then a variety of drainage projects.

#### White Buildings –

The reason to bring this up is that it was brought to my attention that we at highway may be partially responsible for the failure of the septic tank, due to the size of the vehicles we use to plow snow in that parking area.

#### PSNH –

PSNH will cut trees on scenic roads and work with the Road Agent. I have given them the OK to park at the Highway Garage and told them of four locations for dumping wood chips.

#### Conservation/Building –

I received a call from Ed Hunter on May 8<sup>th</sup> regarding concerns on the part of the Conservation Commission expressed to him about what has been going on in the Highway yard. Ed visited on Tuesday May 13<sup>th</sup> and shared concerns of Burr Tupper who couldn't make it. I explained to Ed what had been done, and what we plan for the future.
