Subject: Item # 3-250th funding

The reason for this agenda item discussion is to ask input from the Board as to what budget we should appropriate the funding for the 250th anniversary celebration.

First of all, I would highly recommend the Board ask for \$10,000, which would cover some expenses related to such an important event. I understand that fireworks are part of the inclusion in this request.

The question is whether you want this placed in the operating budget or a separate warrant article. I recommend we place it in the regular operating budget to supplement the regular (Patriotic Events) July 4th celebration line item.

It is my understanding that this amount will be supplemented by a major fundraising effort.
