Debriefing Mapping and Linkages Community Workshop	Although not as well attended as the first community meeting, the quality of the work accomplished at the mapping and linkages workshop was exceptional. New solutions to barriers were generated. Sandi suggested that New Boston may be a community that does not need to go through all five steps to develop a LWC action plan. Attendees agreed the Community is ready to act on some short-term solutions.		
Next Steps	Terry noted Nashua having difficulties with participation. They developed short-term projects to produce more public interest. Several committee members expressed interest in accomplishing some short-term projects. Examples included getting the sidewalks plowed this winter, having a crossing guard for school children who cross from the bank to Clark Hill Road, and buying or renting a speed monitoring trailer system. All present agreed a warrant article for the speed monitoring trailer system was premature but that the other two solutions could be addressed now .
