Farmers' Market Policy

The New Boston Board of Selectmen has established the following policy for the usage of the Town Common for the Farmers' Market activities.

- 1. Review and request must be approved by the Recreation Director prior to annual approval by the Selectmen including dates and times of starting/opening days.
- 2. Authorization for Saturday use only unless waived by the New Boston Board of Selectmen.
- 3. The season will include the dates from June 1st to no later than October 31st.
- **4.** A vendor maximum would not exceed allotted spaces **as determined by the Farmers' Market Coordinator.**
- 5. Vendors shall not park in the Town Hall parking lot with the exception of dropping off and picking up displays and goods.
- 6. Vendors shall provide the Selectmen's office with certificate of minimum \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance that names the Town of New Boston as the certificate holder.
- 7. Each vendor shall adjust the placement of their wares each week to avoid wear to areas impacted the previous week.
- 8. A thorough pick-up, plus site check after each market by a Farmers' Market coordinator.
- 9. Notification and approval required of any change in starting/ending dates and market hours decided on by participating members (based upon date and time given as prescribed above).
- 10. Authentication of a "true farmers' market", that is, a market in which only New Hampshire made/grown products will be sold with the emphasis on farm produce plus homemade foods and crafts as reflected in member majority.
