Temporary Signs on Town Owned Property

- 1. This policy covers all town owned property and the public ways within New Boston. Signs on the property of the New Boston School District will be regulated by the New Boston School Board.
- 2. All applications should be submitted thirty (30) days in advance using the same form the Building Department requires for any other sign.
- 3. The Building Inspector will approve by the Board of Selectmen or applications.
- 4. Applications will be accepted from all agencies and departments of the Town and their subsidiaries (i.e. "Friends" organizations, Auxiliaries, etc.)
- 5. Application will also be accepted from registered New Hampshire Charitable Corporations (non profits) whose activities directly and proximately benefit a reasonable number of New Boston residents.
- 6. Signs giving directions to an event may be in place on the day of the event only.
- 7. Signs announcing an event may be placed one week in advance and removed one day after the event concludes. Signs announcing a series of events may be left up until after the last event.
- 8. Signs shall not obscure sight distances for motorists or pedestrians.
